

City Council Meeting

November 21, 2016

A regular meeting was called to order this date by Mayor Justin Stamer. Roll call was answered by Council Members Dennis Werkmeister, Charles Harper, Justin Fisher, Jay Jones and John Ihle; Superintendent of Utilities Shawn Strubbe, City Clerk Sandy Fritz. Also present: Police Chief Nathan Bremer and Laurie Struve,

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

AGENDA	Harper moved and Ihle seconded the motion to approve the agenda for the November 21, 2016 regular meeting. Motion carried by all ayes.
TREASURERS REPORT	Ihle moved and Harper seconded the motion to approve the Treasurer’s Report for the month of October, 2016. Motion carried by all ayes.
INQUIRES FROM AUDIENCE	None
REPORTS	Strubbe reported the city placed 3 new street lights in the Paullina Business Park. The bucket truck inspection will be next week.
BUSINESS PARK PROPERTY – OPDAHL	Fritz reported the Opdahl business park property has been deeded back to the City of Paullina.
ATV ORDINANCE	The first reading of the ATV Ordinance was conducted.
WEST LOT	Discussion was had on how to proceed with the West Lot and how to finance the project. Various options will be reviewed.
CARPET CLEANING LIBRARY	Werkmeister moved and Ihle seconded the motion to approve having the carpets cleaned in the Paullina Public Library due to a stool running over. Motion carried by all ayes.
NUISANCE VIOLATION	Werkmeister moved and Harper seconded the motion to send a civil citation to Nate Rohwer to abate the nuisances on his property at 308 S Maple Street. The council would like a reply by December 12, 2016. Motion carried by all ayes.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT Discussion was had on what organization should be involved in promoting economic development in the City of Paullina. Various parties will be contacted for a meeting to discuss this issue.

NW IA SOLID WASTE REP Werkmeister introduced Resolution #16-19 entitled "RESOLUTION TO APPOINT JUSTIN STAMER AS THE REPRESENTATIVE AND SHAWN STRUBBE AS THE ALTERNATIVE REPRESENTATIVE TO THE NORTHWEST IOWA AREA SOLID WASTE AGENCY" and moved that the Resolution be adopted.
