AGENDA

Schreck moved and Ihle seconded the motion to approve the agenda for the November 19, 2015 special meeting. Motion carried by all ayes.

MAPLE STREET

Gary Kurth, from DGR, reported that Godbersen-Smith feels that the paving of Maple Street is no longer doable based on the current wet condition of the site and the extended forecast. The contractor suggests applying rock/aggregate surfacing while the weather is somewhat reasonable versus waiting until conditions deteriorate further. The road and driveways will be rocked providing access to each home. A temporary concrete driveway will be created for the residents of the Maple Streets. The street will be open to local traffic only. Requests to have mailboxes with keys will be addressed. Street lights will be connected if possible. O'Brien County will continue to plow the snow on the street. The project will continue in the spring.
