

The Paullina City Council met for Workshop Session on Monday, July 29, 2024, in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 127 S Main St, Paullina, Iowa. Mayor Marlin Sjaarda called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Roll Call was taken. Council Members present: Steve Heeren, Carol Honkomp, Nichole Jacobs, Jean Unrau and Dennis Werkmeister. Motion by Werkmeister, second by Jacobs to approve agenda.

Clerk Wilson led discussion with Council regarding bonding and city projects. Recommendations from MRES and D.A. Davidson were shared with the Council. The Council reviewed and prioritized a number of city projects. Wilson informed the Council of current debt and debt capacity. Council put together a tentative list of projects to be completed in the next five years. List includes: Lagoon pond #1 sludge removal, east lift station upgrade along S. Wood St, City Hall building repairs, fire station bonding and construction, development of Maple and Broadway St lots, fire protection plan needs, and electric generation. Further planning and discussion will be required.
